

## Maple Grove Township Annual Meeting Minutes

Meeting Date: 2017/03/27 - Presented by: Tish Yaros - Clerk

Meeting called to order: 7:00 PM. Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present: Supervisor Krupp, Treasurer Bishop, Clerk Yaros and Trustees Wendling and Anderson. Absent none. The minutes from the March 28, 2016 Annual Meeting were read and motion made by Ron Weisenberger and seconded by Carl Wendling to approve. Motion passed.

Fourteen residents were welcomed, and at this time were asked if there were any petitions to be submitted to the township board, there were none. Krupp asked the residents if there was any old business or new business to discuss, there was none.

After reading the budget for 2017/2018, a motion was made by Rick Wendling, seconded by Tom Angst to approve the budget of \$1,112,012.00. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Carl Wendling, seconded by Ron Weisenberger to retain State Bank (formerly Community State Bank) for our general fund money and all tax money collected. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Ron Weisenberger, seconded by Rick Wendling to hold the regular township board meetings on the third Monday of each month at the township hall starting at 7:00 p.m. year round. Meeting dates are April 17, May 15, June 19, July 17, August 21, September 18, October 16, November 20, and December 18, 2017, January 15, February 19, and March 19, 2018. Motion passed.

Road Projects: Dust control for all Gravel roads, Cross culvert replacement on East Road ( $\frac{1}{3}$  mile north of Chesaning), cross culvert replacement on Bueche road (corner of Ditch and Bueche), Chip seal Misteguay Creek estates, Put the bridge on Bishop between Chesaning and Gary on the "Critical List" for replacement, Crack Seal on Bishop between Ditch and Ferden Rd., Spray ditches as appropriate. If under budget add Grind Bishop Road for  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile North of Chesaning Rd.

As of this time, no projects or meetings are planned on the Misteguay Creek Intercounty Drain Arbitration until this case works its way through the courts.

No public comments.

After no other business was brought up, a motion was made by Pat Andres, seconded by Mike Ebenheoh to adjourn. Motion passed. Meeting was adjourned at 7:23 p.m.
