

Maple Grove Township Board Meeting Minutes

Meeting date: 2018/03/19 - Presented by: Tish Yaros - Clerk

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM. All board members present. The minutes from the February 19th meeting were read and motion made by Clerk Yaros seconded by Krupp to approve. Treasurer Bishop noted a change to Resolution 2-2018-1 that it should read 1.84 acres vs. 1.64 acres. This change was noted. Motion passed.

During the public comment section, there was a very lengthy set of public comments regarding the use of wind energy in Maple Grove township. Opinions were shared both for and against the use of wind energy. Supervisor Krupp reiterated that the board is currently performing research on the subject and waiting on a written recommendation from the wind attorney that was consulted.

At 8:25PM public comment was closed. Supervisor Krupp thanked those attending for being civil and allowing everyone to be heard.

Carolyn Birchmier shared information on a request to add a special resolution to the August ballot. This resolution would move to increase the funding to the twin township ambulance to \$100 per year for a period of 6 years, for the purpose of raising the wages of the EMT's and paramedics. Supervisor Krupp motioned to approve resolution 3-2018-1, supported by Yaros. Resolution Passed.

Chief Andres shared that they are moving forward with truck repairs and that scheduling of equipment testing for the upcoming year is completed.

There were no comments from Treasurer Bishop, Trustee Wendling and Trustee Anderson.

Clerk Yaros gave an update on the web page and shared some statistics on usage.

Supervisor Krupp shared a report about patching and maintenance from the county road commission. He also shared an update that the Misteguay project is continuing through the appeal process and would last through Oct. Also, all road projects for the upcoming year have been identified. He also gave a thanks to the board of review for handling the increase of evaluations due to the near doubling of woodland area. Lastly, the annual meeting will take place on March 26th at 7:00 PM. All are welcome to attend.

Treasurer Bishop shared information on bills #18424 - 18459 - \$42,428.36 and motioned to pay them. The motion was seconded by Wendling, motion passed.

Bishop motioned to adjourn, supported by Wendling, motion passed. Meeting adjourned 8:45 PM.
