MAPLE GROVE TOWNSHIP SAGINAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDINANCE NO: 8-1-2001 ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT

ADOPTED: 8/20/01 EFFECTIVE: 8/27/01

An Ordinance to amend certain definitions set forth in the Maple Grove Township Zoning Ordinance dated 8/27/2001, as amended.

This Ordinance, No. 8-1-2001 shall be known as the Maple Grove Township Zoning Ordinance Amendment.

The Township ordains:

SECTION 1:

The following definitions shall govern the enforcement of the Maple Grove Township Zoning Ordinance:

- 1. FARM. A contiguous tract of land minimum of at least ten (10) acres which is directly devoted to agricultural purposes, including, without limitation, greenhouses, nurseries, orchards, chicken hatcheries, apiaries, fur bearing animal establishments, excluding riding and boarding stables, kennels, quarries, gravel and sand pits.
- 2. FARM ANIMAL, LARGE. Any livestock with four (4) feet with a gross weight equal to or in excess of one hundred (100) pounds at maturity, including, without limitation, cattle, horses, sheep, hogs and goats, any or all of which must be maintained on a contiguous tract of land of at least ten (10) acres.

SECTION 2:

All other provisions not in conflict with the stated amendments shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3:

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its publication and all ordinances or any part of any ordinance in conflict with this ordinance shall be repealed.
