A resident asked when the Planning Commission will hold their meetings. They will be the 1st Monday of the even numbered months. April 1, 2019 will be the next meeting held.

Misteguay Creek Intercounty Drain projects may soon start the bidding process. Permanent Easements have been finalized. Financial pieces are in place. Next scheduled meeting is April 24, 2019 at 10 a.m. at the New Lothrop Village Office.

Road Work: Bishop Road – Chesaning Road to the North ½ mile will be paved. Briggs Road – Ditch South to Johnstone will be paved. Paving is done in two courses: Wear course and Drive course. Dust Control on gravel roads. Ditch Road will have chip seal from East Road to Gasper Road funded by the County.
