

## Maple Grove Township Board Meeting Minutes

Meeting Date: 2019/08/19 - Presented by: Tish Yaros - Clerk

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM. All board members present. The minutes from the July 15th meeting were read and motion made by Yaros, seconded by Anderson, to approve. Motion passed.

Chief Andres reported that the Jaws testing was completed and all issues were repaired. He also noted that the New Utility 4 was repaired under warranty.

Treasurer Bishop noted that the Census Bureau is in the area checking addresses. In 2020, everyone will be mailed a postcard with a special code for people to fill out their census information online. Last time Maple Grove had 91% participation. We hope that we will get the same level or higher participation as this decides how much federal money comes into our township.

Clerk Yaros shared that out of 308 potential voters for the August 6th Special Election only 6 votes were cast from Maple Grove and that the proposal ultimately didn't pass.

Trustee Anderson spoke with Ordinance Officer Olk and the house on Chesaning with tall grass had Besaws come in and brush hog the area and it's looking much better now. The other house on Chesaning road is in a legal dispute with the insurance company and is taking a long time to get the clean up done. The fire originally happened around November 2018.

The Road Commission performed mowing, bringing gravel roads, patrol patching and tile jetting at 1175 Chesaning road.

Krupp noted that the Board of Review met and there was only one item addressed. The decision of the board should be with that resident soon. He also thanked everyone on the board for their participation.

Krupp also discussed that an agreement has been reached on the Johnstone Road project. Hazelton Township will pay 50%, Saginaw County will pay 25% and Maple Grove will pay 25% of the project.

Treasurer Bishop read and motioned to pay bills #19012 thru 19057 for a total of \$40,354.88. Supported by Wendling. Motion Passed.

Clerk Yaros motioned to adjourn the meeting, supported by Wendling, meeting adjourned at 7:17 PM.
