

## Maple Grove Township Board Meeting Minutes

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Meeting Date: 2020/10/12- Presented by: Tish Yaros - Clerk

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. All board members present.

The minutes from the September 19th meeting were read and motion made by Yaros, seconded by Bishop to approve. Motion passed.

Cheryl Hadsall shared county updates including information on absentee ballots, budgets updates, confirming funding of the MSU Extension and noted the budget will open again in March for any potential revisions due to the Covid crisis. She also shared that a temporary court location is being set up to allow some court cases to resume.

Chief Andres shared updates including

- Thanking Rick for painting the parking lot lines
- Dawn's work on a Fire Department grant
- Painting work happening inside the building this month
- Placing a warning check on a local house with an open ordinance violation

Pat also noted he talked to Saginaw County on the intersection of Lincoln and Gary road. Saginaw county did not seem to think there is currently an issue. The firehall will be handing out candy for Halloween from 6-8pm.

Treasurer Bishop noted the waste management meeting was moved to try to accommodate an in-person meeting in November. She also noted the assessment for the mistequay street lighting is dropping and she'd like to drop the rate to \$30 / parcel. She also shared an update on assessment services from BS&A to allow residents to view their property assessment information online.

Clerk Yaros shared updates on the Clerk's meeting she attended. She gave an update on the status of Saginaw County and Maple Groves Absentee Ballots. She also noted that there will be an exit polling taking place and encouraged everyone to vote absentee.

Trustee Wendling shared updates on the Park and Planning commission meetings. The planning commission reviewed about  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the ordinances and they will continue this conversation for the December 7th meeting which means the public hearing will need to be pushed into 2021.

Supervisor Krupp shared that Brian Wendling from public works will be sending out notices for people in the Yaklin drain area as maintenance work will be happening soon.

Treasurer Bishop motioned to pay bills #19479 thru #19504 for a total of \$27,142.15 seconded by Wendling, motion passed.

Krupp motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Yaros. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:33PM.
